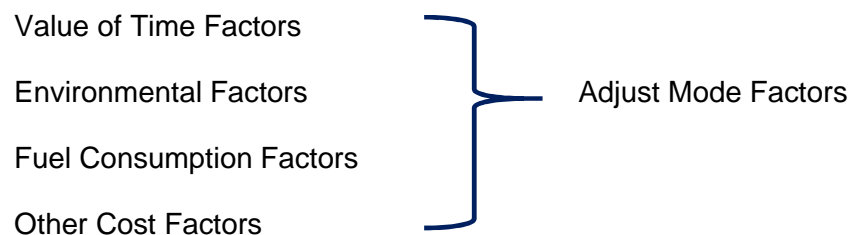


Technical Advisory – Changes to Modes and Travel screens, and Project Import Spreadsheet

The TREDIS Mode screen user interface has been enhanced to simplify updating the project level mode factors and to prepare for new functionality coming soon.

This change reduces the number selection buttons from four (4) to one (1). As a result, the import spreadsheet template has been changed to combine the three mode factors tabs into one.

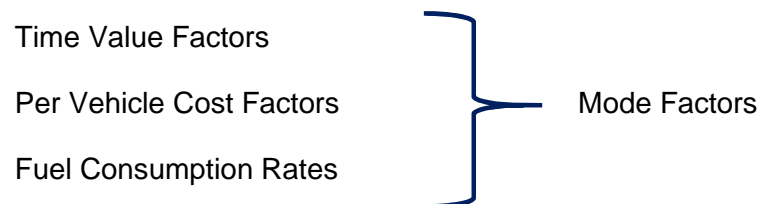
Mode Factor Buttons



The new Adjust Mode Factors table has four tabs which represent the same factors as the four old separate tables, simplifying the data entry.

The changes to the import spreadsheet align the columns with the fields in the new table, reducing confusion.

In addition, a few unused fields (columns) in the mode factor tables have been removed, and therefore have also been removed from the import spreadsheet. A few new fields have been added in anticipation of new features that will be released soon. The order of the fields on the import spreadsheet have also been adjusted to simplify data entry.

With the Travel screen, additional fields are showing in anticipation of a new pavement condition feature. At present, these fields have no effect, but will shortly.
