

## Technical Advisory: Grant Reviewer Account

A new account type has been established to allow USDOT grant application reviewers to be able to view submitted TREDIS projects as part of the grant approval process.

To utilize this feature for standard TREDIS accounts, when ready to share your project with the US DOT Grant Reviewer:

- Open the project to be submitted for review
- Click the properties button on the Project screen
- In the Pop-up window, check the box for US DOT Review Enabled
- Click the Save button

*Note – make sure you have run the analysis so the reviewer will see your results*

Your project will now appear in the US DOT Reviewer's TREDIS account. The reviewer cannot change your project, but may create one or more copies so they may rerun your projects to test the sensitivity of changes to some inputs. The review can only use the regions and modes you have selected and cannot change the project timeline.

The copies the reviewer creates are visible to the originator of the project as a shared project, unless the reviewer deletes the copies. (The reviewer cannot delete the original project).

*Note – You are responsible to inform the reviewers that a TREDIS project was used in creating the application. You are also responsible for the content contained within the project. We recommend citing this in your application.*
